Fellow Eastlakers: On Tuesday, Oct. 16th at 7:30pm we will hold our monthly Community Council General Meeting in the Seward School Library. This will be a working meeting where the Board will update the community members on current projects and anyone who desires will have an opportunity to share ideas and concerns regarding the Eastlake Amea. The topics we will discuss are:

<u>CRITICAL NEIGHBORHOODS</u>: The Department of Community Development will be providing our neighborhood with a half-time planner for a year. The Community Council will participate in the selection process, and will be developing a work plan for the planner. If you have any ideas about planning in Eastlake, we'd like to hear them!

LAND USE:

There is a substantial development proposed for the North West corner of Eastlake & Hamlin. The developers have presented their ideas to the Board. The Board is concerned about the bulk of this project and the traffic flow. We need your input. The developers are willing to work with the neighborhood. <u>SHORELINES</u>:

The Shorelines Master Program is being reenacted. Some of the proposed changes will have an impact on Eastlake:

 Shorelines land will be used only for water-dependent uses.
Removal of PUD's on the water.
Floating homes are considered a water-dependent use and there will be height and bulk restrictions.
In the case of upland property separated from the water by a street or railroad tracks--underlying zoning will apply. This item is of concern to Eastlake as until now we have been able to curb major developments near the water through the Shorelines Act. This will put limitations on our monitoring and preservation of our "neighborhood". DETAILS AT THE MEETING OCT. 16. SEWARD SCHOOL, 7:30pm
